The Vermont Electric Power Company (VELCO) manages Vermont's high-voltage transmission system, the "interstate highway" that moves electricity across the state. VEC and other distribution utilities take that power, lower the voltage, and deliver it to homes and businesses.

While they have different roles, VELCO and VEC work closely together to plan for Vermont's energy future.
