In order for VEC to construct service on your property, you will need to provide an easement to VEC which authorizes us to construct and maintain the equipment necessary to serve you. If your service extension crosses a neighboring property, we will need an easement (and separate checklist form and information) from the neighbor(s) as well.

In order for VEC's Right-of-Way Department to prepare an easement, we will need you to provide certain information about your property that is identified below. Once the easement is prepared, we will mail it to you to be signed before a notary. (Please provide ALL information requested below together with the completed checklist. Failure to do so will delay the preparation of your easement & new service.)
